FQHR Reg # _____ AQHA Reg # _____. I/We do hereby donate a 2023 breeding/service to the Foundation Quarter Horse Registry - Michigan Affiliate (FQHR-MI). This service is transferable to the buyer of the breeding and is to be used in the year 2023. A live foal (one that stands and nurses) is guaranteed only to the extent of one return in the following year, or a substitute mare upon my approval. If a substitute mare or re-breed is accepted, a new contract with all the pertinent information and designating "Substitute" will be issued and will supersede this contract.

Breeding will sell under terms and conditions of current breeding contract, supplied by stallion owner prior to the sale. Foundation Quarter Horse Registry - Michigan Affiliate acts only as an agent in this breeding and will not be responsible for accident, sickness, or death of any stallion, mare and/or foal. FQHR-MI will only accept the stallion service fee. All arrangements and responsibility for this breeding are with the mare and stallion owners and must be completed to make this contract valid. Mare being bred must be designated by June 1 of the year that the breeding is purchased. **DEADLINES WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO.** If the stallion should die or become unfit for breeding prior to the fulfillment of this contract, I will be entitled to credit the price paid toward another available stallion. I understand that the resulting foal will be automatically eligible for the Stallion Service Sale class-Mare owners (weanlings only).

In consideration of the above transfer, I agree to make all payments and abide by all conditions of this contract. It is acknowledged that the Michigan FQHR acts only as an agent.
